Dear Mr. Freeman:

As promised in our call this morning, this letter provides a written explanation of the Consumer Advocate's request for clarification on two additional responses by Tennessee Water to the Consumer Advocate's discovery requests.

- Request 1-16. Tennessee Water (TWS) provided no response to last sentence of the request "If no such policies provide insurance coverage for (a) damages or (b) business interruption coverage, discuss whether TWS or Utilities Inc., or any other affiliate intends to acquire such insurance to provide protection for similar events which may occur in the future." Please provide a response.
- Request 1-22. Tennessee Water objected to the discovery to the extent it calls for a legal conclusion regarding what point in time service lines are no longer "used and useful" for vacant properties. The Consumer Advocate is not seeking a legal conclusion but the accounting treatment of these services lines for vacant lots.
