Enclosed for filing in the above-referenced case, please find an original and thirteen copies of Kentucky Utility Company's ("KU") biweekly update. This letter will serve as the third update requested by the Tennessee Public Utility Commission ("TPUC") in the above-referenced proceedings. KU will continue to file periodic biweekly updates with the TPUC until such time as the TPUC has acted on KU's Joint Petition.

In Kentucky, as previously reported, the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("KPSC") established a procedural schedule for the case.¹ The procedural schedule provides that initial requests for information were due to the Joint Applicants on November 20, 2017; the KPSC Staff and the Attorney General filed limited requests for information by this deadline. The Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers, Inc. did not submit any data requests. On December 4, 2017, the Joint Applicants filed their responses. Supplemental data requests to the Joint Applicants were due no later than December 15, 2017. The Attorney General submitted one supplemental data request. The KPSC and Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers, Inc. did not submit any supplemental data requests. The response to the Attorney General's supplemental data request is due December 27, 2017. A hearing is not scheduled. In early January 2018, the Joint Applicants expect to request the KPSC to ask the parties whether a hearing should be


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held, and absent such a request, to take the matter under submission for consideration and decision.
