
ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO WITHDRAW PETITION AND CLOSING DOCKET

This matter is before the Hearing Officer of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“Commission” or “TPUC”) for consideration of the *Motion to Withdraw Petition* (“*Motion*”) filed by Kingsport Power Company, d/b/a AEP Appalachian Power (“KPC” or the “Company”) on July 3, 2019. KPC states it seeks to withdraw its *Petition for Approval of a Storm Damage Rider Tariff* filed in this docket on December 15, 2017, because all of the issues in this docket were resolved in Docket No. 18-00038.¹ In addition, KPC states the Intervenors in both this docket and Docket No. 18-00038, the Consumer Advocate Unit in the Financial Division of the Office of the Tennessee Attorney General and the East Tennessee Energy Consumers, do not object to the *Motion*.

The Hearing Officer finds the request is well taken and should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

The *Motion to Withdraw Petition* filed by Kingsport Power Company, d/b/a AEP Appalachian Power is granted and this docket is closed.
