#### Data Request 3-001:

Refer to "Staff\_1-3\_Attachment\_1.xlsx" provided in response to TPUC Staff's Discovery Request 3. Specifically, refer to rows 6, 7, 8, 12 and 14. Provide the following information:

- (a) Explain how an employee classified as exempt would be eligible for overtime compensation.
- (b) Specify the type of employees represented by these charges?
- (c) At what rate is this Overtime calculated at?

#### Response 3-001:

- a. Kingsport, along with other AEP operating companies, maintains an exempt overtime policy for certain of their exempt employees who are sometimes required to put in extraordinary hours due to such things as major service restoration (e.g. from storm damage), other unplanned and planned outages, and unusual peak work loads. The overtime required is beyond the uncompensated overtime that would normally be expected and associated with the position. As a policy decision, the Company has decided in specified situations that are not the "norm" to pay these individuals a straight-time overtime rate (based on their salary) for those hours exceeding 40, 45 or 50 (depending on the particular exempt position). See CPAD 3-001, Attachment 1 on the enclosed CD for a complete copy of the Exempt Overtime Plan in effect in 2013, relevant portions of which were provided in the Company's response to CPAD 1-1. Each of the individuals covered by the Plan meets the definition of a "managerial" employee under the FLSA.
- b. The exempt AEP operating company employees that received the major storm restoration (MSR) overtime compensation listed on rows 6, 7, 8, 12, 13 and 14 of Staff 1-3, Attachment 1, met the criteria for, and were paid in accordance with, the overtime policy included in the response to CPAD 3-1. Exempt employees were from Kingsport and two other AEP operating companies that sent employees to help with service restoration in KgPCo's service territory. In total, 20 AEP operating company exempt employees received overtime for 483 hours of overtime worked. The types of employees that received straight-time overtime compensation are listed below:

Dispatch employees – These employees dispatched the outages to the local crews and directed any switching of the Company's facilities.

Inspectors and Line Coordinators – These employees oversaw the activities of both the contract and company crews respectively that were restoring service.

Engineers – These employees were involved in both local dispatching, as well as reviewing loading of facilities as service was being restored.

Technologists – These employees assessed the outages in the field and determined what would be required to restore service before dispatching physical crews to the outage location.

Managers and Supervisors – These employees managed the recovery effort in the areas of dispatch, support and the local (Kingsport) district, or supervised the recovery effort with regard to both the contract and company crews.

- c. When the 2013 winter storm was declared a major service restoration effort, the MSR pay provisions became effective:
- a. Employees in salary grade 1-16 positions were paid overtime for hours worked in excess of 40 hours in a work week at a straight-time rate.
- b. Employees in salary grade 17-20 positions were paid overtime for hours worked in excess of 45 hours in a work week at a straight-time rate.
- c. Employees in salary grade 21-28 positions were paid overtime for hours worked in excess of 50 hours in a work week at a straight-time rate.

The compensatory exempt overtime amounts listed on rows 6, 7, 8, 12, 13 and 14 of Staff 1-3, Attachment 1 reflect employees' straight-time overtime rates for the appropriate number of hours.
