ORDER GRANTING PERMISSION TO PLEAD AND PRACTICE PRO HAC VICE

This matter is before the Hearing Officer upon the *Application to Appear Pro Hac Vice* (“*Application*”) filed by Floyd R. Self, attorney for Chattanooga Gas Company (“CGC”). The *Application* was filed on March 2, 2018.

Mr. Self’s *Application* states he is licensed, in good standing, and admitted to practice law in the State of Florida and further, that no disciplinary actions or investigations are pending against him.<sup>1</sup> Mr. Self agrees to subject himself to the disciplinary jurisdiction of the Board of Professional Responsibility of the Supreme Court of Tennessee and the Courts of Tennessee in any manner arising out of his conduct in these proceedings and agrees to be bound by the rules governing the conduct of attorneys appearing before the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“Commission” or “TPUC”).

Upon review, the Hearing Officer finds that the *Application* complies with Rule 19 of the Rules of the Tennessee Supreme Court and Tenn. Comp. R. & Reg. 1220-1-2-.04(7).


