CLEC applicants are required, by statute, to demonstrate their managerial, financial and technical abilities to provide the services for which they seek authority. To assist the Commission in its review of Onvoy, LLC's application for certificate of convenience and necessity to provide competing local exchange and long distance telecommunications services on a facilities and resold basis in Tennessee, you are requested to provide the following:

- 1) Does Onvoy, LLC intend to use the assumed name "Inteliquent" in Tennessee? If so, please amend the petition to include the assumed name.
- 2) The surety bond provided lists the "Principal" as Michael Donahue. The telecommunications provider surety bond should be in the name of the provider. Include any assumed names on the bond as well.
- 3) The financial information filed under seal referenced "accompanying notes to consolidated financial statements." There were no accompanying notes. Provide the "accompanying notes to consolidated financial statements" referenced in the financial exhibit.

It is requested that this information be provided no later than 2:00 pm on April 3, 2018 and that you reference Docket Number 18-00023 on the response. In accordance with TPUC rules submit either (1) thirteen written copies of your response or (2) four written copies and an electronic version.
