

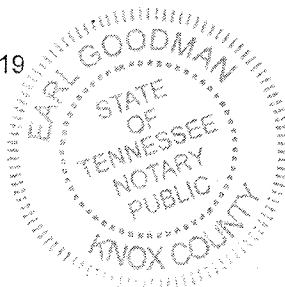

Notice is hereby given that, pursuant to its existing Annual Review Mechanism tariff, Atmos Energy Corporation (the Company) filed a Petition with the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (TPUC) on August 31, 2018, in Docket No. 18-0087, proposing to change its rates for natural gas service, now in effect and a Response to Order Opening Investigation to the Commission's Order Opening an Investigation and Requiring Deferred Accounting Treatment on March 29, 2018 in Docket No. 18-0084. The rates proposed by the Company are subject to approval by the TPUC. The TPUC may adopt, reject, increase or decrease any of the proposed rates in part or in whole. A complete copy of the proposed rate changes and the reasons for them are on file with the TPUC and are available for public inspection. A complete copy is also available in the Company's local offices. The Company has requested this change in rates in accordance with the procedure approved in its Annual Review Mechanism tariff. The projected impact of the proposed changes on the average residential customer is a decrease of approximately \$16.99 per year. The projected impact of the proposed changes on the average small commercial class customer is a decrease of approximately \$16.99 per year. 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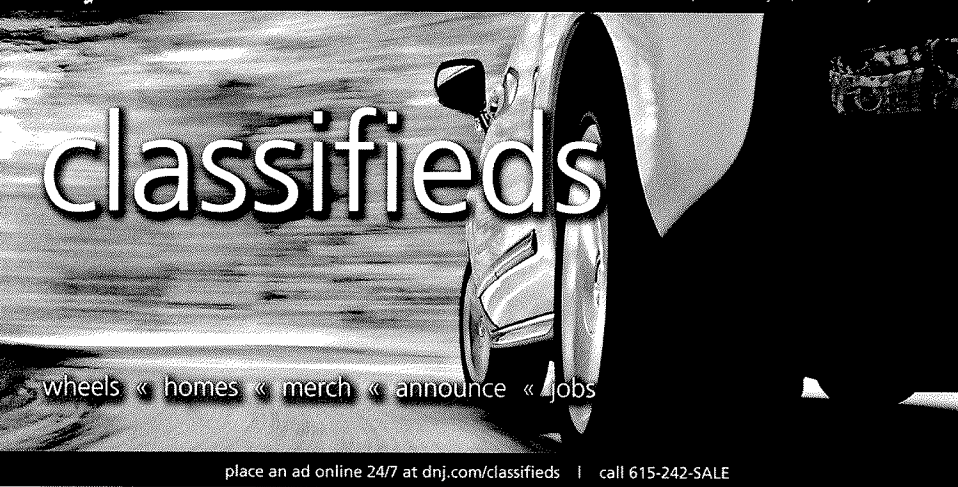
