## ORDER CONVENING A CONTESTED CASE PROCEEDING AND APPOINTING A HEARING OFFICER

This matter came before Chairman David F. Jones, Commissioner Kenneth C. Hill and Commissioner Keith Jordan of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (TPUC or Commission), the voting panel assigned to this docket, during a regularly scheduled Commission Conference held on May 14, 2018 for the purpose of determining whether to convene a contested case proceeding and appoint a Hearing Officer. On April 2, 2018 Tennessee-American Water Company (TAWC) filed its Response in which TAWC discusses how the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act impacts the utility's financial operations, any resulting excess deferred tax reserve, and proposes a method for how certain benefits should be addressed.

During the Conference, the Commissioners voted unanimously to convene a contested case proceeding and appoint the Commission's General Counsel, or her designee, to act as Hearing Officer to prepare this matter for hearing, with authority to handle all preliminary matters, including but not limited to, establishing a procedural schedule, considering dispositive motions, ruling on intervention requests and discovery issues, and entering a protective order, as needed.
