Re: Docket 18-00057: Petition of Kentucky Utilities Company For An Order Authorizing The Issuance Of Securities And The Assumption Of Obligations And An Order Amending And Extending Existing Authority With Respect To Revolving Line of Credit

Dear Ms. Dillon:

This letter is in response to Mr. Kettles' letter dated May 21, 2018 seeking the status of and periodic updates on the similar filings of Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU") pending before the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("KPSC") and the Virginia State Corporation Commission ("VSCC").

On May 11, 2018, KU filed an application with the KPSC (Case No. 2018-00153) requesting an order (1) authorizing the issuance of securities and the assumption of obligations and (2) amending and extending existing authority with respect to revolving line of credit. The KPSC issued a letter indicating the application has no deficiencies on May 18, 2018. The KPSC has taken no further action.

On May 14, 2018, KU d/b/a Old Dominion Power Company ("KU/ODP") filed an application with the VSCC (Case No. PUR-2018-00076) requesting an order (1) authorizing the issuance of securities and the assumption of obligations; (2) amending and extending existing authority with respect to revolving line of credit; and (3) authorizing KU/ODP to engage in an affiliate transaction under Chapter 4 of Title 56 of the Code of Virginia. The VSCC issued a Memorandum of Completeness indicating that the KU application is complete on May 17, 2018.¹ The VSCC has taken no further action.

KU will continue to provide the Tennessee Public Utility Commission ("TPUC") with periodic updates of the proceedings and will file orders with the TPUC when they are issued by

the KPSC and the VSCC. KU anticipates that, as in previous dockets, TPUC approval will be contingent upon approval by the KPSC and the VSCC. KU respectfully requests that when the Staff completes its review, that KU's Petition be placed on the TPUC Docket for consideration even if these approvals have not yet been obtained. KU requests the matter be placed on the TPUC Commission Conference Docket for hearing on July 23-24, 2018.

As provided in the letter, KU is sending the original and four copies of this letter to Ms. Dillon. KU will also email an electronic file of this letter to Sharla.Dillon@tn.gov.
