
NOTICE OF APPROVAL OF AMENDMENT
TO THE INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT

This Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement (the "Amendment") negotiated between AT&T Tennessee and Granite Telecommunications, LLC ("Granite") was filed with the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the "Commission") on May 18, 2018¹. The Amendment was filed in order that the Commission may consider rates, terms, and conditions for the reselling of Individual Case basis ("ICB") contracts.² The Amendment was negotiated pursuant to 47 U.S.C. §§ 251 and 252. The Amendment has been reviewed, and no portion discriminates against a telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the Amendment.

A Notice was filed by the Commission on June 27, 2018 advising that the Amendment would be deemed approved by the Commission within ten business days of the filing of the Notice unless an objection to the Amendment was filed with the Commission. No objection to the Amendment has been received by the Commission.

Pursuant to the Notice and absent any objection having been filed with the Commission, the Amendment is approved effective as of the date of this notice or July 11, 2018, whichever is sooner.
