# Franklin Housing Commission labors over affordable housing incentive plan

Can the government agency finally beat the hard knocks?

After being directed by the Franklin Board of Mayor and Aldermen (BOMA), initiated by Alderman at Large Pearl Bransford, the Franklin Housing Commission is penning an incentive program to entice developers to create affordable housing.

Developers wishing to bring affordable and workforce housing units to Franklin could end up bypassing high-cost city impact fees for roads and parks if the policy is approved.

The draft policy presents the first glimmer of light at the end of a long tunnel in finding solutions to the lack of affordable housing options in Franklin.

Over the past several years, the commission has been wrought with disappointment and setbacks in its efforts to find and implement opportunities to create affordable housing developments.

## Franklin Housing Commission setbacks

In 2015, the state legislature voted on House Bill 1632, sponsored by Rep. Glen Casada, R-Franklin, blocking city governments from implementing mandatory housing policies, including affordable housing mandates.

Just last year, the Housing Commission vied for a bid to bring affordable housing units to property located at Spencer Creek, competing against proposals by the Discovery Center of Murfreesboro and a Cheekwood Golf Course expansion plan.

Ultimately the Hous-

ing Commission's Spencer Creek proposal failed to gain traction, and BOMA voted instead to expand the Cheekwood golf course at Spencer Creek. The Cheekwood Golf Course already has a golf course located across the street off Mack Hatcher. Its expansion, BOMA said, seemed to be appropriate for the site.

In 2014, a Franklin Housing Needs Analysis, conducted by Denver-based BBC Consulting, identified the lack of workforce housing in Franklin as a housing "gap."

Subsequently, the Franklin Housing Commission went to work, devising an inclusionary zoning policy upon the recommendation of the housing needs analysis. However, BOMA ultimately rejected the inclusionary zoning proposal in 2015, which never reached a vote, and soon after, the new state law (HB 1632) was implemented rendering any such mandates as illegal.

However, the Housing Commission has seen some victory in its advocacy for changing the land use of the city-owned "The Hill" property to "mixed residential" designation in Envision Franklin, the city's land use plan. Just last week, the Franklin Planning Commission approved an amendment to Envision Franklin, designating "The Hill" as "Mixed Residential," which could be the first step, paving the way for an affordable and workforce housing development, proposed by three community nonprofits and Franklin Housing Authority. The Hill is located adjacent to Sonic on Fifth Avenue and is the previous site of the city

## Draft policy denotes offset to city impact fees

Many have long suggested that city of Franklin development fees are a barrier to the development of new affordable or workforce housing. The high price of land has also presented barriers to the creation of affordable housing.

The current average home price in Franklin is \$671,018, as of August, according to the Williamson County Association of Realtors (WCAR). The U.S. Census reports the median annual income in Franklin was \$88,961, as of 2016.

"Our community needs to be vital, needs great diversity in careers, jobs and housing options," previous Housing Commission Chairman John Besser said recently.

"We need a place for teachers, police officers and service workers to live."

Meanwhile, the Williamson Inc. Trends Report 2018 reported that 63 percent of Williamson County chamber survey respondents would like to see more affordable housing options in Williamson County for employees.

The Housing Commission's draft policy could accomplish creating more housing options for lower income families and individuals such as those teachers, police officers, restaurant workers and other service workers that the city has long talked about serving.

## Affordable Housing Incentive Program draft

The draft policy proposes offsetting, or crediting, 100 percent of Road Impact Fees and 100 percent of Parkland Impact Fees per unit for state registered nonprofits or for-profit developers who would build affordable housing to meet certain criteria.

Applications for the pro-

posed incentive program would be reviewed and evaluated by the Housing Commission.

Qualifying criteria is drafted as follows:

- Development units must be owner-occupied
- Provide dwellings units affordable to households whose incomes are no greater than 80 percent of the Greater Nashville Average Median Household Income (AMI) set forth by Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) guidelines.

For example, a family of one at 80 percent of the median income level would make approximately \$41,950 per year, while a family of four at 80 percent of the median income level would make \$59,900 per year.

According to Greater Nashville MSA calculations, an affordable home for a family of one based on 80 percent of the city median income level, would cost \$174,065. (Note: Separate calculations for workforce housing for a family of one using the same criteria would cost \$326,449.)

Using the same MSA calculations for a family of four "up to" 80 percent of the city's median income level an affordable home would cost \$248,545. (Note: workforce housing at 80 percent of the city's income level would cost \$466,178.)

- The affordability of the units will be assured for a minimum of 30 years through deed restrictions or other methods, including fee-based third party monitoring.

• The developer may utilize LTC, THDA tax-exempt bonds, THDA HOME grant, Tennessee Housing Trust Fund or similar program to assist in financing the development.

## Is 100 affordable units a year possible?

The commission also proposes that that BOMA may appropriate up to \$1 million annually for projects that participate in the incentive program. According to housing commissioner Steve Murray, executive director of Williamson County Community Housing Partnership (CHP), the amount could create almost 100 affordable units in Franklin annually. He even suggested raising the proposal to \$2 million, which would create 200 units, he said.

"That could change the face of Franklin," Murray said.

Also, the commission discussed that applicants must demonstrate financial viability. The commission discussed appointing a subcommittee to vet applicants.

The Housing Commission is still tweaking the metrics of criteria for the policy.

Alderman Dana McLendon, who serves on the housing commission, said he is concerned about basing eligibility on family size instead of home price.

"We need to keep in mind who we are trying to deliver this product to," McLendon said, emphasizing that removing barriers to housing is the focus.

Alma McLemore, a long-time proponent of affordable housing, said she is proud of the strides the housing commission is making.

"I don't think we have ever gotten this far," McLemore said.

"This is a good conversation."

The Housing Commission will continue to make changes to the draft policy before it is presented to BOMA as a completed document.

Lane explained a grassroots initiative, "Working On Restoring the Hood" (WORTH), she founded in an effort to improve her neighborhood, which some say faces low-income wages, a struggle with access to health care, food insecurity and situations that contribute to at-risk youth in Franklin.

"Sometimes we ask God for things, and then we don't move our feet," Lane said.

"If we don't bond, we don't build. We have to bond. I want change in Williamson County."

"Let's win this thing girls," Lane said to the candidates.

Local Democratic candidates

Democratic candidates running for a state House and Senate seats also spoke to the small crowd of supporters at the drive, held at the Victory Tennessee office, a centralized location for lo-

cal Democratic candidates to meet and participate in campaign activities.

Candidate Rebecca Purington, facing Brandon Ogles for the 61st House seat for a chance to replace retiring longtime legislator Rep. Charles Sargent, R-Franklin, outlined her top priorities.

"I want to make sure children have a solid education," Purington said firstly.

Purington previously said that although Williamson County Schools is the highest achieving district in the nation, Tennessee schools still rank in the 30s in achievement compared to the rest of the nation.

She also said she would like to see enhanced Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM) education and healthcare coverage for those who are not insured or underinsured.

Purington said health care conversations need to be at the forefront of the legislature.

"Our legislature is not talking about it [health

care)," Purington said. "I am ready to get in there and talk about it."

Although Tennessee has a low unemployment rate, "Tennessee leads the nation in minimum wage jobs," Purington cited, calling for higher wages for workers.

Purington moved to Williamson County after a 30-year career on the operational side of the aerospace and

defense industry. Before she sold it, Purington operated her own business, providing crisis communications technology to various clients including the U.S. defense department and military.

Franklin resident Kristen Grimm, candidate for state Senate, who is running against incumbent Rep. Jack Johnson, R-Franklin, also emphasized the importance

of getting health care to those who are uninsured.

Caring for a son who has had 23 surgeries in his lifetime, Grimm said she understands the plight of those who are sick, calling health care a "compassionate" system and explaining she would like to "bring a more

merciful narrative back to the legislature and do what is right for the state of Tennessee."

Grimm, who introduced Lane to the audience, reiterated the importance of voting.

"Voting is your voice," she said.



## Busboy who comforted Robert Kennedy after shooting dies

**LOS ANGELES (AP)**—When Robert F. Kennedy decided to duck through the kitchen of the Ambassador Hotel in Los Angeles after declaring victory in the 1968 Democratic presidential primary, Juan Romero revealed at his good fortune.

It meant the 18-year-old busboy might get to shake hands with his hero — the man he'd assured himself would be the next president of the United States — for the second time in two days.

Romero had just grasped Kennedy's hand when gunshots rang out, one of them striking the senator in the head.

Kennedy would die the next day and the teenage Mexican immigrant who had idolized him would carry the emotional burden of that encounter for most of his life.

## Felt guilty

"I remember him one time saying he felt guilty," his daughter, Josefina Guerra, said Thursday. "He thought it was his fault."

Her father explained: "'If I wouldn't have extended my hand, he wouldn't have gotten shot,'" she said.

Romero died Monday in a Modesto, California, hospital following a heart attack. Rigo Chacon, a longtime family friend and former TV newsman, told The Associated Press on Thursday. He was 68.

Romero, who moved from Los Angeles decades ago, spent most of his life in the Northern California cities of San Jose and Modesto, Chacon said.

He worked in construction, including concrete and asphalt paving, enjoying the often-grueling physical labor with no

intention of retiring any time soon.

## 'He was so happy'

"Juan was a big, brawny guy, a muscular guy and seemingly in good health," said Chacon, adding his death came as a shock to family and friends.

The divorced Romero had recently met a woman and moved in with her in Modesto. He wanted to buy a house and to travel, his daughter said.

"He was happy, he was so happy," she said. "It was just such a short time."

For decades, each time Romero saw black-and-white news photos of himself — a baby-faced busboy gently cradling Kennedy as he lay sprawled on the hotel's concrete kitchen floor — he would wonder what more he should have done to save Kennedy.

Only recently, he said during rare interviews this year, did he finally come to terms with that struggle.

He said he still carried the example Kennedy had set as he campaigned for equality and civil rights.

"I still have the fire burning inside of me," Romero said.

## Mexican native

Born in the small town of Mazatlan, in the Mexican state of Sonora, Romero lived in Baja California until his family received permission to bring him to the U.S. as a 10-year-old.

The family lived in blue-collar East Los Angeles and Romero was a student at Roosevelt High School in 1968, the year Chicano students started organizing walk-outs to protest discrimination against Mexican-American students. As the son of a tough disciplinarian father, however, he said he was too afraid to take part.

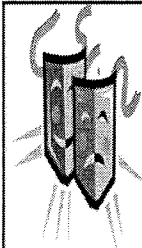
