**NOTICE OF APPROVAL OF AMENDMENT
TO INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT**

This Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement (the "Amendment") negotiated between AT&T Tennessee and XO Communications Services, LLC was filed with the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the "Commission") on July 12, 2018.¹ The Amendment was negotiated pursuant to 47 U.S.C. §§ 251 and 252. The Amendment has been reviewed, and no portion discriminates against a telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the agreement.²

A Notice was filed by the Commission on September 6, 2018 advising that the Amendment would be deemed approved by the Commission within ten business days of the filing of the Notice unless an objection to the Amendment was filed with the Commission. No objection to the Amendment has been received by the Commission.

Pursuant to the Notice and absent any objection having been filed with the Commission, the Amendment is approved effective as of **September 16, 2018**.

² The Interconnection Agreement was initially arbitrated in Docket No. 98-00123 under the name of NextLink Wireless, Inc., and amended in Docket No. 03-00567.
