## ORDER RE-SUSPENDING TARIFF THROUGH FEBRUARY 19, 2019

This matter is before the Hearing Officer appointed by the voting panel of Commissioners of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission ("Commission" or "TPUC") and designated by General Counsel to administer certain preliminary issues that may arise during the preparation of this matter for hearing before the Commission. On September 7, 2018, Tennessee-American Water Company ("TAWC" or the "Company") and Thunder Air Inc. d/b/a Jasper Highlands Development, Inc. ("Thunder Air") filed an Expedited Joint Petition of Tennessee-American Water Company and Thunder Air, Inc. d/b/a Jasper Highlands Development Inc. for Approval of an Asset Purchase Agreement and for the Issuance of a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Joint Petition"). Along with the Joint Petition, TAWC filed a proposed tariff with an effective date of October 6, 2018.

Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-5-103(a) permits the Commission, pending a hearing and determination, to suspend any rate increase, change, or alteration for an initial period not to exceed

Officer initially suspended the tariff through December 17, 2018, however, because the Commission's investigation, hearing, and final determination on the Company's proposed tariff cannot be completed by that date, the Hearing Officer hereby re-suspends the effectiveness of the tariff through February 19, 2019.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

The effective date of the proposed TPUC No. 19 Tenth Revision of Sheet No. 3-C Cancelling Ninth Revision of Sheet No. 3-C filed by Tennessee-American Water Company on September 7, 2018, is hereby re-suspended **through February 19, 2019**, or until further order of the Tennessee Pubic Utility Commission, whichever occurs sooner.
