TENNESSEE-AMERICAN WATER COMPANY'S SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE TO FIRST DISCOVERY REQUEST NO. 4 OF THE CONSUMER PROTECTION AND ADVOCATE DIVISION

Tennessee-American Water Company ("TAWC"), by and through counsel, hereby submits its Supplemental Response to the First Discovery Request No. 4 propounded by the Consumer Protection and Advocate Division of the Office of the Attorney General ("CPAD").

GENERAL OBJECTIONS

- 1. TAWC objects to all requests that seek information protected by the attorneyclient privilege, the work-product doctrine and/or any other applicable privilege or restriction on disclosure.
- 2. TAWC objects to the definitions and instructions accompanying the requests to the extent the definitions and instructions contradict, are inconsistent with, or impose any obligations beyond those required by applicable provisions of the Tennessee Rules of Civil Procedure or the rules, regulations, or orders of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission ("TPUC" or "Commission").

- 3. The specific responses set forth below are based on information now available to TAWC, and TAWC reserves the right at any time to revise, correct, add to or clarify the objections or responses and supplement the information produced.
- 4. TAWC objects to each request to the extent that it is unreasonably cumulative or duplicative, or seeks information obtainable from some other source that is more convenient, less burdensome or less expensive.
- 5. TAWC objects to each request to the extent it seeks information outside TAWC's custody or control.
- 6. TAWC's decision, now or in the future, to provide information or documents notwithstanding the objectionable nature of any of the definitions or instructions, or the requests themselves, should not be construed as: (a) a stipulation that the material is relevant or admissible, (b) a waiver of TAWC's General Objections or the objections asserted in response to specific discovery requests, or (c) an agreement that requests for similar information will be treated in a similar manner.
- 7. TAWC objects to those requests that seek the identification of "any" or "all" documents or witnesses (or similar language) related to a particular subject matter on the grounds that they are overbroad and unduly burdensome, and exceed the scope of permissible discovery.
- 8. TAWC objects to those requests that constitute a "fishing expedition," seeking information that is not relevant or reasonably calculated to lead to the discovery of admissible evidence and is not limited to this matter.
- 9. TAWC does not waive any previously submitted objections to the CPAD's discovery requests.

SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE TO DISCOVERY REQUEST NO. 4

4. How Thunder Air, Inc. justifies the operation of the utility without a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity?

RESPONSE:

The provision of water services by Thunder Air, Inc. is consistent with Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-101(6)(B)(i). We will supplement this response with JHPOA's organizational documentation on file with the Tennessee Secretary of State (SOS Control #000685272). A consent from JHPOA to the acquisition that is the subject of the Joint Petition, along with a lease and a management agreement between JHPOA and Thunder Air, Inc., are attached hereto as **COLLECTIVE EXHIBIT D**.

SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE:

The consent of JHPOA to the acquisition was not attached as a part of **COLLECTIVE EXHIBIT D** in the original response filed on November 6, 2018. JHPOA's consent to the acquisition is attached to this supplemental response as **EXHIBIT E**. A certified copy of JHPOA's charter, along with JHPOA'S Certificate of Existence/Authorization and its most recently submitted Tennessee Corporation Annual Report Form, are attached to this supplemental response as **COLLECTIVE EXHIBIT F**.

CONSENT

THIS CONSENT is made and entered into as of the 6th day of August, 2018, by and between Thunder Air, Inc., a Tennessee corporation ("Thunder") and Jasper Highlands Property Owners' Association, Inc., a Tennessee nonprofit corporation ("JHPOA").

RECITALS

- 1. JHPOA operates a water system for the exclusive use of the residents of the Jasper Highlands development in Marion County, Tennessee, having been unable to obtain water services directly from the South Pittsburg Board of Water Works and Sewers.
- 2. Thunder owns the infrastructure of the water system, which provides water services to customers in the Jasper Highlands, and is responsible for managing the water system under an agreement with JHPOA;
- 3. JHPOA holds the customer information for the water system and handles the billing for water services;
- 4. Thunder desires to sell the water system and Tennessee American Water Company ("TAWC") desires to purchase the water system and take over management of the system with JHPOA's responsibilities terminated;
 - 5. JHPOA desires to consent to the transfer of the water system to TAWC.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and conditions stated herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. <u>Recitals</u>. The foregoing recitals are herein fully incorporated by reference the same as if fully incorporated herein.
- 2. <u>Agreement</u>. JHPOA consents to the transfer of the water system. The parties agree to terminate the management arrangement regarding the water system. At the closing of the transfer, JHPOA will deliver all information in its possession regarding the water system to TAWC, including but not limited to, customer addresses and account information.
- 3. <u>Governing Law.</u> This Consent shall be governed by the laws of the State of Tennessee.
- 4. <u>Counterparts</u>. This Consent may be executed in two (2) or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to be an original. Execution and delivery of this Consent by delivery of a facsimile or .pdf copy bearing the facsimile or .pdf signature of a party shall constitute a valid and binding execution and delivery of this Consent by such party.

CHARTER

OF

JASPER HIGHLANDS PROPERTY OWNERS' ASSOCIATION, INC.

The undersigned natural person having the capacity to contract and acting as the Incorporator of corporation under the Tennessee Nonprofit Corporation Act, T.C.A. §48-51-101, et seq., adopts the following Charter for the Corporation:

1. **NAME:** The name of the Corporation is:

JASPER HIGHLANDS PROPERTY OWNERS' ASSOCIATION, INC.

- 2. **PRINCIPAL OFFICE:** The address of the principal office of the Corporation in the State of Tennessee shall be 210 Battle Creek Road, South Pittsburg, Marion County, Tennessee, 37380. The mailing address of the Corporation is Post Office Box 4737, Chattanooga, Hamilton County, Tennessee, 37405.
- 3. **REGISTERED AGENT:** The initial registered agent for service of process for the Corporation is Mr. Dane Bradshaw, 210 Battle Creek Road, South Pittsburg, Marion County, Tennessee 37380.
- 4. **MUTUAL BENEFIT CORPORATION:** The Corporation is a not for profit mutual benefit Corporation.
 - 5. **PERPETUAL:** The existence of the Corporation is perpetual.
 - 6. INCORPORATOR: The name and address of the Incorporator is:

John H. Cameron, Jr. 28 Courthouse Square, Ste. 100 Post Office Box 759 Jasper, Marion County, Tennessee 37347

7. **MEMBERS:** The Corporation shall have members. Every member or entity who is a record owner of a lot in Jasper Highlands Subdivision located in Marion County,

Tennessee ("Jasper Highlands") pursuant to Declaration of Covenants, Conditions, and Restrictions of Jasper Highlands ("Declarant") as amended from time to time, may be a member for so long as the member shall continue to be a record owner. Persons or entities who hold an interest merely as security for the performance of an obligation are not members of the Corporation. Membership shall be appetent to and may not be separated from ownership of any lot which is subject to assessment by the Corporation.

8. **PURPOSE**: The Corporation is organized for the purpose of carrying on one or more of the exempt functions of an owner's association for which a not for profit corporation may be organized under the Tennessee Non-Profit Corporation Act, including but not limited or restricted in any way through a Board of Directors the business activities, management, maintenance, care and preservation of Jasper Highlands.

Further purposes of the Corporation include the promotion of the health, safety, and welfare of the Owners of Jasper Highlands and in addition thereto the power to:

- (a) Fix, levy and collect payment of all charges and assessments including such licenses, taxes or other governmental charges as may be levied or imposed against the Corporation.
- (b) Have and exercise any and all powers, rights and privileges which a Corporation organized under the provisions of the Tennessee Non-Profit Corporation Act relating to not for profit corporations may now or hereafter have or exercise.
- 9. **LIMITATION OF LIABILITY:** To the fullest extent permitted by the Tennessee Non-Profit Corporation Act and the laws of the State of Tennessee, no present or future Director of the Corporation (or his/her estate, heirs, and personal representatives) shall be liable to the Corporation or its members for monetary damages for any breach of

fiduciary duty as a Director of the Corporation.

- 10. **LIABILITY OF DIRECTOR:** Any liability of a Director (or his/her estate, heirs, or personal representatives) shall be further eliminated or limited to the fullest extent allowed by the laws of the State of Tennessee as may herein after be adopted or amended.
- 11. **DISSOLUTION:** The Corporation may be dissolved only if such dissolution if approved by the affirmative vote of at least two-thirds percent (2/3%) of the members. Upon dissolution of the Corporation, other than incident of a merger or consolidation, the assets of the Corporation, if any, shall be dedicated and conveyed to one (1) or more appropriate public agency on the express condition that such assets shall be devoted to purposes as nearly as practical to the same as those to which they were required to be devoted by the Corporation. In the event that such dedication is not accepted then in such assets shall be conveyed to a non-profit corporation, non-profit association, non-profit trust or other non-profit organization on the express condition that such assets shall be devoted to purposes as nearly practical as those which are required to be devoted by the Corporation.
- 12. **EARNINGS:** No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to any of its members, directors, officers, or other private persons except through acquisition, construction, management, maintenance or care of the Corporation's profit or through the rebate of excess membership dues, fees or assessments. Notwithstanding this provisions reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the Corporation affecting one (1) or more of its purposes.
- 13. **AMENDMENTS:** Amendment to this Charter shall require the affirmative vote of at least two-thirds percent (2/3%) of the members.

14. **EFFECTIVE DATE:** This document is to be effective upon the filing by the Secretary of State.
