

The goal and design of any procedural schedule is to efficiently move the proceedings forward to a hearing and final conclusion on the merits. Nevertheless, a procedural schedule’s effectiveness directly depends on cooperation by the parties in meeting the individual benchmark dates. Based on the joint proposed procedural schedule filed by the parties, Tennessee Wastewater Systems, Inc. (“TWSI”) and the Consumer Advocate Unit of the Office of the Attorney General (“Consumer Advocate”), the Hearing Officer hereby establishes the Procedural Schedule set forth in Exhibit A attached to this Order.
