## NOTICE OF APPROVAL OF RESALE AGREEMENT

This Resale Agreement (the "Agreement") negotiated between Citizens Telecommunications Company of Tennessee d/b/a Frontier Communications of Tennessee, LLC ("Frontier") and Onvoy, LLC ("Onvoy") was filed with the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the "Commission") on November 1, 2018.
