ORDER GRANTING COMPANY'S REQUEST FOR CANCELLATION OF CCN

This matter came before Chairman Herbert H. Hilliard, Vice Chairman David F. Jones, Commissioner Robin L. Morrison, Commissioner Kenneth C. Hill, and Commissioner David Crowell of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission ("TPUC" or the "Commission"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, during a regularly scheduled Commission Conference held on May 20, 2024. The Tennessee Regulatory Authority, now TPUC, issued an order granting Light Source Communications, LLC ("Light Source" or the "Company") a CCN to provide operator services and/or resell interexchange services in Docket No. 18-00124. On April 26, 2024, the Commission received a request from the Company to cancel its CCN. The Company has neither active operations nor customers in Tennessee. The Company is in good standing with the Commission concerning payment of mandatory inspection fees. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Commissioners voted unanimously to grant the Company's cancellation request.
