Dear Chairman Morrison:

The above-captioned Docket is scheduled for a Hearing on the Merits on March 11, 2019. In its pre-filed testimony, the Consumer Advocate highlighted two items: (1) Piedmont's cost of installing distribution mains; and (2) Piedmont's computation of the property tax expense component of the Integrity Management Rider (IMR). Only the second issue proposes a change to the Company's revenue requirement.

In light of the generic docket opened by the Commission as Docket No. 19-00007, which is designed to address changes to the IMR, the Consumer Advocate believes that in the interest of judicial economy, these issues can be addressed in the newly-opened Docket. The Parties have engaged in discussions concerning these items agree on this approach. If the Commission also approves this approach, there will be no need to conduct a contested hearing, and the Parties will appear before the Commission to announce the agreement.
