ORDER RE-SUSPENDING TARIFF THROUGH JULY 15, 2019

This matter is before the Hearing Officer appointed by the voting panel of Commissioners of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“Commission” or “TPUC”) and designated by General Counsel to administer certain preliminary issues that may arise during the preparation of this matter for hearing before the Commission. On January 16, 2019, pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-5-103 *et seq.*, Tennessee-American Water Company (“TAWC” or the “Company”) filed its *Petition* seeking approval of the proposed Production Costs and Other Pass-Throughs Rider percentage, along with the proposed tariffs.


Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-5-103(a) permits the Commission, pending a hearing and determination, to suspend any rate increase, change, or alteration for an initial period not to exceed three months from the proposed effective date of such increase, change, or alteration.¹ The Hearing Officer initially suspended the tariff through April 1, 2019 and re-suspended the tariff until July 1, 2019; however, because the Commission’s investigation, hearing, and final determination on the Company’s proposed tariff could not be completed by that date, the

Hearing Officer hereby re-suspends the effectiveness of the tariff through July 15, 2019.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

The effective date of the proposed Thirteenth Revised Sheet No. 12-Riders-1 filed by Tennessee-American Water Company on January 16, 2019, is hereby re-suspended **through July 15, 2019**, or until further order of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission, whichever occurs sooner.
