ORDER GRANTING REQUEST TO WITHDRAW AND CLOSING DOCKET

This matter is before the Hearing Officer of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission ("Commission" or "TPUC") upon a Request to Withdraw the *Petition to Amend Certificate of Convenience and Necessity* filed by Tennessee Wastewater Systems, Inc. ("TWSI"). TWSI states the "developer has informed the utility that due to higher than expected construction costs, market conditions, and the complexity of executing the project, they are no longer moving forward with the purchase of the Ozburn property." TWSI asserts that with the developer's termination of the project, a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") is no longer necessary and seeks to withdraw its petition.

The Hearing Officer finds the request is well taken and should be granted.
