ORDER RE-SUSPENDING TARIFF THROUGH DECEMBER 9, 2019

This matter is before the Hearing Officer appointed by the voting panel of Commissioners of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“Commission” or “TPUC”) and designated by General Counsel to administer certain preliminary issues that may arise during the preparation of this matter for hearing before the Commission. On March 4, 2019, pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-5-103 *et seq.*, Tennessee-American Water Company (“TAWC” or the “Company”) filed its *Petition in Support of the Calculation of the 2019 Capital Recovery Riders Reconciliation* (“*Petition*”).


Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-5-103(a) permits the Commission, pending a hearing and determination, to suspend any rate increase, change, or alteration for an initial period not to exceed three months from the proposed effective date of such increase, change, or alteration.¹ The Hearing Officer initially suspended the tariff until July 1, 2019 and re-suspended the tariff until November 4th; however, because the Commission’s investigation, hearing, and final

determination on the Company's proposed tariff cannot be completed by that date, the Hearing Officer hereby re-suspends the effectiveness of the tariff through **December 9, 2019**.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

The effective date of the proposed TPUC No. 19 Fifteenth Revised Sheet No. 12-Riders-1 filed by Tennessee-American Water Company on March 4, 2019, is hereby re-suspended **through December 9, 2019**, or until further order of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission, whichever occurs sooner.
