**AMENDED ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF THROUGH JULY 1, 2019**

---

This matter is before the Hearing Officer appointed by the voting panel of Commissioners of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“Commission” or “TPUC”) and designated by General Counsel to administer certain preliminary issues that may arise during the preparation of this matter for hearing before the Commission. On March 4, 2019, pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-5-103 *et seq.*, Tennessee-American Water Company (“TAWC” or the “Company”) filed its *Petition in Support of the Calculation of the 2019 Capital Recovery Riders Reconciliation* (“*Petition*”).

Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-5-103(a) permits the Commission, pending a hearing and determination, to suspend any rate increase, change, or alteration for an initial period not to exceed three months from the proposed effective date of such increase, change, or alteration.<sup>1</sup> Because the Commission’s investigation, hearing, and final determination on the Company’s proposed tariff cannot be completed prior to the April 1, 2019 effective date, the Hearing Officer hereby suspends the effectiveness of the tariff through July 1, 2019.


**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**
