Cartwright Creek LLC, a provider of wastewater services in some areas of Williamson County, has asked the Tennessee Public Utility Commission to permit the utility to increase tap fees from \$5,000 to \$10,000, to be consistent with tap fees charged by the City of Brentwood and to provide revenue needed for repairs and upgrades to the utility's plant.

The increase will only apply to new construction in developments served by Cartwright Creek.
