ORDER APPROVING WITHDRAWAL OF *PETITION* AND CLOSING DOCKET

This matter is before the Hearing Officer upon the *Notice of Withdrawal* filed by Cartwright Creek, LLC seeking to withdraw the *Petition of Cartwright Creek, LLC to Amend Service Territory to Include the Wilson Parcel and Garrett Parcel for the Troubadour Development in Williamson County* (“*Petition*”). The Hearing Officer approves the *Notice of Withdrawal*, and the docket is closed. If the *Petition* is re-filed, Cartwright Creek should file it in accordance with the process established for a public utility seeking to provide service to a contiguous territory pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-201(a) set forth in the Hearing Officer’s *Initial Order* issued on January 16, 2020 in Docket No. 19-00061.<sup>1</sup>

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

1. The *Notice of Withdrawal* is approved, and the docket is administratively closed.

Code Ann. § 65-4-201(a) set forth in the *Initial Order* issued January 16, 2020 in Docket No. 19-00061.
