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**ORDER APPROVING WITHDRAWAL OF *PETITION TO INTERVENE FILED BY  
TENNESSEE WASTEWATER SYSTEMS, INC.***

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This matter is before the Hearing Officer for consideration of the *Withdrawal (sic) of Petition to Intervene* filed by Tennessee Wastewater Systems, Inc. (“TWSI”) seeking to withdraw the *Petition of Tennessee Wastewater Systems to Intervene* (“*Petition to Intervene*”) granted by the Hearing Officer in the *Order Granting Petition to Intervene Filed by Tennessee Wastewater Systems, Inc.*<sup>1</sup> TWSI states that King’s Chapel Capacity, now Superior Wastewater Systems, LLC (“Superior”), and TWSI had discussions regarding Superior providing wastewater service to the adjacent Hill and Roberts parcels that are currently in TWSI’s service area. According to TWSI, “...if the Commission finds that KCC [Superior] has the financial, managerial and technical capabilities to provide wastewater service on the adjacent Hill and Roberts properties, TWSI will transfer those properties from TWSI’s Milcrofton service territory to the service territory of KCC [Superior].” TWSI maintains there are no further issues between the parties and seeks to withdraw



its *Petition to Intervene*. The Hearing Officer finds the request is well taken and the *Petition to Intervene* filed by TWSI is withdrawn.
