## MOTION TO TAKE ADMINISTRATIVE NOTICE

Cartwright Creek, LLC ("Cartwright Creek") asks the Tennessee Public Utility Commission ("the Commission") to take administrative notice of the evidentiary record in Docket 19-00034. There are no other parties to this docket, and I am authorized to say that the Consumer Advocate Office has informed me that they do not intend to intervene. Therefore, the motion is unopposed.

This docket is a request for the Commission to authorize Cartwright Creek to spend up to \$550,000 from the utility's escrow funds to make upgrades and repairs at the utility's Grasslands collection system. Those repairs and upgrades are described in detail in the testimony and exhibits of Mr. Bruce Meyer filed in Docket 19-00034. In that docket, the Commission approved an increase in Cartwright Creek's tap fees for the purpose of funding the repairs and upgrades at Grasslands.

The utility has put out bids for the work and selected the lowest bidder. A copy of the winning bid has been filed in this docket. I have also filed a copy of a proposal from the Inflo Design Group to oversee the repairs and upgrades. The total amount of both contracts is \$493,650. Cartwright Creek is ready to begin work as soon as the Commission approves the company's request as described in the Petition.
