
- 1. Please confirm whether the liner thicknesses in specification section 33 01 40 are to be interpreted as "finished thicknesses"
- Yes. References to liner thicknesses are finished thicknesses.
- 2. CIPP specification Part 2.01 Materials, A., 3. Solvent and styrene free. However, the resins listed are not styrene free. Can I get some clarification?
 Cartwright Creek has no specific requirements regarding styrene. All products and applications shall comply with applicable State and Federal requirements for CIPP products. In general, however, products acceptable in nearby Metro Water Services projects and City of Brentwood projects will be acceptable for this project.
 - 3. Can you give some clarification on where grouting for services would be needed (bid form items 8 and 9)?

After consideration, the original pay items 8 and 9 for grouting have been removed from the bid form. This was included in an effort to obtain pricing for possible instances where flow might need to be attenuated in order to perform cured-in-place lining (lateral seals). In lieu of these items, the bid quantity for excavatable point repairs – bid item #15 – has been increased from 3 to 5.

- 4. Please clarify intended sampling and testing regimen.

 The intention is to obtain at least one sample per CIPP delivery ("reefer truck").
- 5. Please clarify insurance requirements.

 Insurance requirements are as spelled out in Section 00 73 00 of the specifications.

Dear Mr. Meyer,

We appreciate the opportunity to provide you with a proposal for construction phase services for the 2019 Cartwright Creek Sewer Rehabilitation Project. IDG will work with Cartwright Creek, LLC, and the contractor, Insituform Technologies, to implement the project's construction in conformance with the contract documents.

Tasks to be included in the construction phase services include:

- 1. Prepare contracts and conformed contract documents for execution.
- 2. Conduct preconstruction meeting and distribute minutes.
