CLEC applicants are required, by statute, to demonstrate their managerial, financial and technical abilities to provide the services for which they seek authority. To assist the Commission in its review of Point Broadband Fiber Holding, LLC's application for certificate of convenience and necessity to provide competing intrastate and local telecommunications services in Tennessee, you are requested to provide the following:

- 1) A surety bond or letter of credit in compliance with Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-125(j). Please use the Tennessee Public Utility Commission's standard bond form. A copy is attached for your convenience.
- 2) The Certificate of Existence from the Tennessee Secretary of State's Office.
- 3) The application states "Applicant elects Market Regulation." Affirm that the company understands the notice of intent to operate pursuant to the Market Regulation Act should be handled in a separate filing after a hearing on the CCN application has been held.
- 4) Exhibit A to Point Broadband Fiber Holding, LLC's application indicates one of its subsidiary companies is Sunset Fiber, LLC. Our records indicate Sunset Fiber, LLC is certificated by this agency and is not current on its annual statement of gross earnings and computation of inspection fees. We have also received notice that Sunset Fiber, LLC's surety bond, as required by Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-125(j), is set to expire on July 5, 2019. Does Point Broadband Fiber Holding ensure that its subsidiary company will file all required fees and maintain the required bond?
- 5) Does Point Broadband Fiber Holding, LLC agree to pay all inspection fees by April 1 of each year as well as maintain a continuous bond or letter of credit?

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It is requested that this information be provided no later than 2:00 pm on July 12, 2019 and that you reference Docket Number 19-00054 on the response. In accordance with TN PUC rules submit either (1) thirteen written copies of your response or (2) four written copies and an electronic version.
