The Consumer Advocate Unit in the Financial Division of the Tennessee Attorney General's Office (Consumer Advocate) has reviewed the Petition of Cartwright Creek, LLC for Declaratory Ruling (Petition) filed on July 22, 2019, and Direct Testimony of Bruce Meyer on Behalf of Cartwright Creek, LLC (Direct Testimony) filed on July 30, 2019. In the Petition, Cartwright Creek, LLC requests an order that the requirement of a certificate from the Commission pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-201(a) does not apply to the extension of a wastewater service to a contiguous unserved parcel of land.
