

In response to your communication and request for information to Mayor Wise, please know that we have only one-(1) PEG channel that is active with this City and this City receives no specific revenue or fee from the cable provider for PEG access support. The State assumed the franchise and the City no longer issues a local franchise to the cable providers, within the city limits, since the 2008 Tennessee State Cable Franchise Act was adopted.

If there is a way to receive support or a fee for the PEG channel from the cable provider, the City of Johnson City would appreciate information on how to make this possible. Thank you.
