In compliance with Section 7-59-304(a)(5)(A) of the Tennessee Code, Point Broadband Fiber Holding, LLC respectfully informs the Tennessee Public Utility Commission of an intra-company transaction regarding video services that will be transparent to both consumers and local governments in Tennessee. Specifically, Point Broadband Fiber Holding, LLC will transfer its multichannel video distribution businesses to its affiliate PB Tennessee Asset Entity, LLC.

To the extent necessary, the Applicant respectfully requests that the Commission update the name on the Certificate of Franchise Authority from Point Broadband Fiber Holding, LLC to PB Tennessee Asset Entity, LLC upon receipt of this letter.

The affiliate PB Tennessee Asset Entity, LLC, will continue to provide video services pursuant to, and subject to the same terms and conditions as currently provided by Point Broadband Fiber Holding, LLC. Tennessee consumers will continue receiving the same high-quality service they receive currently without the need for any additional action on their part. Additionally, local governments will continue receiving the same fees and benefits as they receive today.

Finally, please be advised for your records that the principal office is now located at 2901 Society Hill Rd., Opelika, Alabama 36804. I will continue to be the main contact for video services.
