- 2) A surety bond or irrevocable letter of credit in the amount of \$20,000 pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. §65-4-125(j).

It is requested that this information be provided no later than 2:00 pm on October 18, 2019 and that you reference Docket Number 19-00087 on the response. In accordance with TPUC rules submit either (1) thirteen written copies of your response or (2) four written copies and an electronic version.
