Said franchise fee shall be paid quarterly to Blount County with each payment due and payable within sixty (60) days from the end of the quarter for which payment is due, so long as the Company shall supply and sell natural gas to the public within said County, or so long as this franchise is in effect. The matter has been set for hearing on November 4, 2019 beginning at 1:00 p.m. CST in the TPUC's hearing room on the ground floor of the Andrew Jackson Staff Office Building at 500 Deaderick Street, Nashville, Tennessee.
