ORDER GRANTING PERMISSION TO PLEAD AND PRACTICE PRO HAC VICE

This matter came before the Hearing Officer upon the *Motion for Admission and Application to Appear Pro Hac Vice and Declaration of Mark A. Keffer in Support Thereof* (“*Motion*”), filed by Mark A. Keffer, attorney for BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Tennessee (“AT&T”). The *Motion* was filed on May 13, 2020.

Mr. Keffer’s *Motion* states he is licensed, in good standing, and admitted to practice law in Virginia, West Virginia, and the District of Columbia, and further, that no disciplinary actions or investigations are pending against him.¹ Mr. Keffer agrees to subject himself to the jurisdiction of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) in any manner arising out of his conduct in such proceedings and agrees to be bound by the rules governing the conduct of attorneys appearing before the Commission.

Upon review, the Hearing Officer finds that the *Motion* complies with Rule 19 of the Rules of the Tennessee Supreme Court and Tenn. Comp. R. & Reg. 1220-1-2-.04(7). Accordingly, the *Motion* filed by Mark A. Keffer for permission to practice before the

Commission in the proceedings in this matter is approved.
