ORDER SUSPENDING AMENDED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This matter is before the Hearing Officer of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“Commission” or “TPUC”) to suspend the procedural schedule established in the *Order Establishing Amended Procedural Schedule* (“*Amended Procedural Schedule*”) issued on April 7, 2020. The initial target hearing date in this matter was May 11, 2020. The hearing was postponed because the May hearing would have been held via Webex video due to public health concerns because of the COVID-19 pandemic, and BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Tennessee (“AT&T”) and Cellular South, Inc. d/b/a C Spire (“C Spire”), the parties in this matter, indicated they thought it would be best to wait until a live hearing could be held. Subsequent Commission Conferences were also held virtually via Webex. The Hearing Officer was recently informed that Governor Bill Lee extended remote public meetings and hearings through the end of the year. The Hearing Officer contacted the parties to see whether they wanted to go ahead with a virtual hearing. Both AT&T and C Spire stated they would still prefer to wait until a live hearing could be held. Therefore, the Hearing Officer suspends the *Amended Procedural Schedule* until a live hearing can be held in this matter.
