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ORDER GRANTING NAVITAS MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

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This matter is before the Hearing Officer of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“Commission” or “TPUC”) for consideration of the *Motion by Navitas TN NG, LLC for Extension of Time to File an Answer* (“*Motion*”) filed on March 23, 2020. In its *Motion*, Navitas TN NG, LLC (“Navitas”) requests an extension of time until April 24, 2020, to file an Answer to the *Complaint* of B&W Pipeline, LLC (“B&W”) filed against Navitas on January 9, 2020. As grounds for the *Motion*, Navitas avers that because of shelter in place orders due to Coronavirus Disease 2019 (“COVID-2019”), filing the Answer by the March 27, 2020 deadline would be problematic. In addition, Navitas states that a current matter before the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“KYPSC”) could lead to clarification and possible settlement in this docket, and a decision may be rendered in that docket by the KYPSC by mid-April. Further, Navitas states B&W does not oppose an extension in time to file the Answer.

The Hearing Officer finds that Navitas’ *Motion* is well taken and should be granted.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

1. The *Motion by Navitas TN NG, LLC for Extension of Time to File an Answer* is

granted.

2. Navitas TN NG, LLC shall file its Answer to the *Complaint* on April 24, 2020.
