**ORDER GRANTING NAVITAS’S MOTION FOR FURTHER EXTENSION OF TIME**

---

This matter is before the Hearing Officer of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“Commission” or “TPUC”) for consideration of the *Motion by Navitas TN NG, LLC for Further Extension of Time to File an Answer* (“*Motion*”) filed on April 20, 2020. On March 23, 2020, Navitas TN NG, LLC (“Navitas”) filed a Motion requesting an extension of time until April 24, 2020, to file an Answer to the *Complaint* of B&W Pipeline, LLC (“B&W”) filed against Navitas on January 9, 2020. As grounds for its Motion, Navitas stated conditions related to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (“COVID -19”) made it difficult to file its Answer by the deadline and that a current matter before the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“KYPSC”) could lead to clarification and possible settlement in this docket. Navitas stated a decision may be rendered in the related docket by the KYPSC by mid-April. The Hearing Officer granted Navitas’s initial Motion for an extension of time. On April 20, 2020, Navitas filed another *Motion* seeking additional time to file its Answer because the KYPSC did not deliberate the related matter in April, but Navitas expected KYPSC to do so by mid-MAY. Therefore, Navitas seeks a further extension of time to file its Answer until

May 22, 2020. In addition, Navitas states B&W does not oppose a further extension in time to file the Answer.

The Hearing Officer finds that Navitas's *Motion* is well taken and should be granted.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

1. The *Motion by Navitas TN NG, LLC for Further Extension of Time to File an Answer* is granted.
2. Navitas TN NG, LLC shall file its Answer to the *Complaint* on May 22, 2020.
