RE: Docket No: 20-00016 – Proposed Transfer Of Direct Control Of Illinois Network Alliance, LLC From Adams Telecom, Inc., Alhambra Grantfork Communications, Inc., Egyptian Communications Services, Inc., Hamilton County Communications, Inc., MTC Communications, Inc., Progressive Voice and Data, Inc., Shawnee Communications, Inc., Technology Group, LLC, Wabash Independent Networks, Inc., and WINS, LLC, to Missouri Network Alliance, LLC

The agency received a letter on February 6, 2020 that was assigned to TPUC Docket 20-00016. The letter describes a transaction whereby control of the certificated company, Illinois Network Alliance, LLC (“INA”) will be transferred to the certificated company Missouri Network Alliance, LLC (“MNA”).

INA elected market regulation via a letter dated April 9, 2018 that was assigned to TPUC docket number 18-00047. MNA elected market regulation via a letter dated January 13, 2020 that was assigned to TPUC docket number 20-00007. T.C.A. § 65-5-109(n) provides a description of the regulatory requirements that apply to companies that elect Market Regulation. The transaction, as described, is governed by T.C.A. 65-4-112 which is not a regulatory requirement that applies to companies that have elected Market Regulation. As such, the transaction described in the correspondence dated February 6, 2020 does not require approval. As no action is required by the agency, please close the above referenced docket.
