This letter is a request for confirmation from the Tennessee Public Utility Commission that a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) is not required for the on-site wastewater system serving the proposed BrightStone Campus. This letter is required by Williamson County and the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation for final approval of the wastewater system.

BrightStone proposes to construct, own, and operate a post-secondary educational facility for adults who have special needs with teaching, therapeutic, and residential offerings for its students. The campus will be located at 4174, 4176, and 4184 Columbia, Pike, Franklin, TN 37064. The campus will consist of a Learning, Art, and Enterprise Center; Administration Building; Clinic; Gymnasium; Aquatic Center; 18 residential homes providing varied levels of care according to need; a horticulture center and farm; an outdoor recreation area and eco-classroom; and an equine education and therapeutic riding program.

BrightStone is a single 501(c)3 nonprofit formed on July 14, 1999. Its Executive Director is Brenda K. Hauk. BrightStone is located at 140 Southeast Parkway Court, Franklin, Tennessee 37064.

The facilities will be served by a non-traditional, on-site wastewater system consisting of STEP tanks for primary treatment, forcemain collection system, Aquapoint Bioclere wastewater treatment plant, and drip irrigation disposal. BrightStone will own and operate the system under a State Operation Permit/UIC Permit from TDEC. They will retain the services of a licensed operator to operate the system. BrightStone maintenance personnel with assist with day-to-day maintenance. BrightStone will not charge water or sewer fees at BrightStone Campus. All buildings will be owned and operated by BrightStone. Water will be purchased from HB & TS Utility District at a master meter serving the development.


