Dear Mr. Kendall:

The Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“TPUC” or “Commission”) have received your request for extension of time to complete wastewater system for the Forest Trails Subdivision in accordance with Commission Rule 1220-04-13-.09(7). Staff has reviewed the request and the information provided in Aqua Green’s supplemental filings and determined that the information provided substantially conforms to the requirements set forth in the rule for extension of time.

The Commission Rule provides that the extension of time is “not to exceed one year from the original deadline... .”¹ Therefore, the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (“CCN”) is extended to July 19, 2024.

Please continue to file reports updating the status of the provision of wastewater service to Forest Trails Subdivision as directed in the Commission’s *Order Approving Petition to Amend Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity*. In addition, all other conditions to the issuance of the CCN for the Forest Trails Subdivision set forth in the *Order* remain in effect.²
