DURING THE CORONA VIRUS COVID-19 PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY**

Dear Chairman Morrison:

B&W Pipeline, LLC (B&W) has received your letter of March 19<sup>th</sup> requesting initial information along with weekly updates of our operational and response plans to ensure the continuity of safe and reliable utility service to our customers during this health emergency. It is B&W's understanding that the weekly updates are now required on a monthly basis beginning September 15, 2020. Please consider this letter as B&W's updated response to your request for October 15, 2020

B&W currently provides gas transportation service to a single gas distribution utility with operations in both Tennessee and Kentucky. At this time, no adjustments to our standard operating procedures have been required because of the Covid-19 outbreak and we are not currently aware of any aspect of our operations that could be potentially impacted by the current health emergency.

B&W will update our preparedness response to the Commission on a monthly basis. Please feel free to contact me anytime if you have any questions in regard to this response.
