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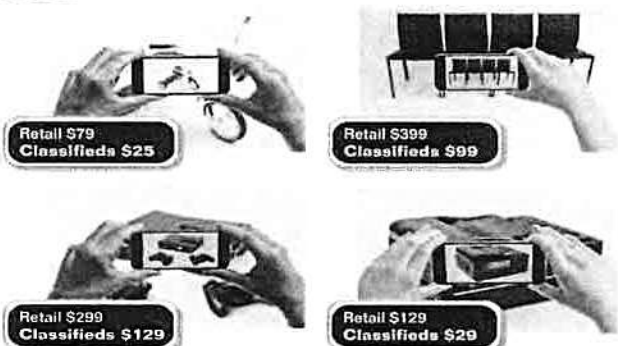
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## LEGAL NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that pursuant to its existing Annual Review Mechanism, Chattanooga Gas Company (the Company) filed a petition with the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (TPUC) on May 29, 2020, in Docket 20-00049, proposing to change its rates for natural gas service now in effect. Any rate changes are subject to the approval of the TPUC. The TPUC may adopt, reject, increase or decrease any of the rate changes in part or in whole. A complete copy of the Company's recommended rates based upon accelerating certain tax credits and benefits to lower the rate increase along with the proposed rate changes that would otherwise apply without accelerating the tax credits and benefits are on file with the TPUC and are available for public inspection. A complete copy is also available in the Company's local office. The Company's filing is made in accordance with the procedures for its Annual Review Mechanism approved by the TPUC. As requested by the Company after accelerating certain tax credits and benefits, the average residential customer would see a rate increase of approximately \$1.26 per month. The Company's proposed rate impact on the average small commercial and industrial general service customer after acceleration of tax credits and benefits would be an increase of approximately \$6.88 per month. New rates are proposed to be effective October 1, 2020. This matter is currently set for hearing on September 14, 2020, at 9:00 a.m. central. Due to COVID-19, it is yet to be determined whether the hearing will be conducted by video teleconference or in person at the TPUC Hearing Room on the ground floor of the Andrew Jackson State Office Building, 500 Deaderick Street, Nashville, Tennessee. Public notice of the final date, time, and manner of the hearing will be posted on the TPUC website on or about September 4, 2020. The Company's current rates, recommended rates after applying accelerated tax credits and benefits, and proposed rates without accelerated tax credits and benefits are as follows and do not include gas cost that is recovered through the Purchase Gas Adjustment.
