RE: City of Germantown Public, Educational, and Governmental Access channels

On April 20, 2020, The City of Germantown received a Notice of TPUC Receipt of Application for or Amendment to Certificate of Franchise Authority and Official Request for Information from the Tennessee Public Utility Commission.

Per Tenn Code Ann. § 7-59-309(a)(1), the City of Germantown is providing the following information regarding the public, educational, and governmental access channels provided by Comcast Cable Communications Management, LLC ("Comcast"):

- (1) The incumbent has activated three (3) PEG channels in the City
 - a. Channel 17 – Germantown Community Television.
 - b. Channel 18 – WYPL TV-18
 - c. Channel 19 – City News & Information Channel
- (2) The incumbent franchise agreement authorizes three (3) PEG channels.
- (3) The incumbent franchise is required to pay the City an amount equal to five (5%) percent of the Company's gross revenue plus a Capital Contribution Fee of \$1.34 per subscriber to support the capital needs of public, educational, and government access and the facilities and equipment for such access.
