Applicant is a wholly owned subsidiary of Vero Fiber Networks, LLC, a licensed and certificated company within the State of Tennessee. See Docket 18-00008. Applicant does not have any affiliates, or subsidiaries. A copy of Applicant's Organizational Chart is attached hereto as **Exhibit A**.

3. Corporate Information

Applicant is a Delaware limited liability company organized on August 15, 2019. See Certificate of Formation in **Exhibit B.** A copy of Applicant's authority to transact business in the State of Tennessee is provided in **Exhibit C.** The names and addresses of the principal corporate officers are in **Exhibit D.** There are no officers in Tennessee. The biographies of the principal officers and any other key technical staff are in **Exhibit E.**

4. Applicant possesses the managerial, technical, and financial ability to provide local telecommunications service in the State of Tennessee as demonstrated below

A. Financial Qualifications

Applicant has the financial ability to render the local exchange telecommunications services for which this Application is submitted. In support of its financial qualifications, Applicant submits the pro forma financial report of its corporate parent, on a confidential basis, provided in **Confidential Exhibit F.** Because Applicant is a privately held company, Applicant requests that the financial statements appended hereto as Exhibit F be treated as confidential.

In accordance with T.C.A. § 65-4-125(j), Applicant will submit a corporate surety bond or irrevocable letter of credit, as applicable, prior to providing service.

B. Managerial Ability:

As previously shown on **Exhibit E** of this Application, Applicant has the managerial expertise to successfully operate a telecommunications enterprise in Tennessee. Applicant's management team has extensive management and business experience in telecommunications.

C. Technical Qualifications

Applicant will satisfy the standards established by the Commission, including quality of service and billing standards required of all LEC's regulated by the agency. As noted in the biographies in **Exhibit E**, the principal officers of the company include many individuals with several years of telecommunications expertise. Thus, Applicant is technically qualified to provide local exchange service in Tennessee.

5. Proposed Service Areas

Applicant seeks authority to provide local exchange telecommunications services on a statewide basis.

6. Types of Service to be Provided

Applicant seeks authority to enter the Tennessee market as a provider of limited facilities-based local exchange service, specifically by primarily providing broadband and video services to schools and libraries through the federal E-rate program, and to other persons and businesses in Tennessee. Applicant intends to deliver an aggregation of technologies utilizing fiber optic cable depending on the customer's location and needs. If requested by a customer and if financially feasible, the Applicant will also offer TDM telephone service through a special contract with the customer.

7. Repair and Maintenance

Applicant understands the importance of effective customer service for local service customers. Applicant will make arrangements for its customers to call the company at (800) 691-8376, its toll-free customer service number. In addition, customers will be able to contact the company in writing at the headquarters address, as well as via email. The toll-free number will be provided on each customer's agreement for services. The customer service contact person knowledgeable about Applicant's operations is John Real, EVP. Mr. Real's mailing address, telephone number, and email address are in Section 1 of this Application.

8. Small and Minority-Owned Telecommunications Business Participation Plan (T.C.A. § 65-5-112):

9. Toll Dialing Parity Plan:

Should the Applicant provide TDM telephone service at the request of a customer, the Applicant will provide toll dialing parity.

10. Notice of Filing:

Applicant has served notice of this Application on the seventeen (17) incumbent local exchange telephone companies in Tennessee with a statement regarding the company's intention of operating geographically. See **Exhibit H** for the Notice of Filing and list of carriers served.

11. Numbering Issues:

Should the Applicant provide TDM telephone service at the request of a customer, the Applicant will comply with the Commission's rules on number assignment and conservation.

12. Tennessee Specific Operational Issues:

Questions 1-4 concerning Tennessee Specific Operational Issues are not applicable to the broadband services Applicant intends to offer. Should the Applicant provide TDM telephone service at the request of a customer, the Applicant will comply with all Commission operational requirements, including those listed here. Gregory Friedman will be responsible to work with the Commission on resolving customer complaints. His contact information is in Section 1 of this Application. Applicant does not intend to telemarket its services in Tennessee.

13. Miscellaneous:

- **b.** Applicant will not require customer deposits.
- c. As a recently-formed entity, Applicant is not authorized to operate in any other state. Applicant has not been denied requested certification in any jurisdiction. Applicant has not been subject to complaints in any of the states in which it is now seeking to do business.
- d. Subsequent to the approval of this Application, Applicant will file any necessary tariffs prior to providing the proposed services covered by this Application.

CONCLUSION

Grant of the Application will further the goals of the Tennessee Legislature and further the public interest by expanding the availability of competitive telecommunications services in the State of Tennessee. In addition, intrastate offering of these services is in the public interest because the services will provide Tennessee customers increased efficiencies and cost savings. Authorizing Applicant to provide telecommunications services will enhance materially the telecommunications infrastructure in the State of Tennessee and will facilitate economic development.

Full Tilt respectfully requests that the Commission enter an order granting it a certificate of convenience and necessity to operate as a competing telecommunications service provider and authority to provide a full range of local exchange services on a facilities-based and resale basis throughout the State of Tennessee. Full Tilt also respectfully requests expedited treatment for approval of its application. For the reasons stated above, Full Tilt's provision of these services would promote the public interest by providing high-quality service at competitive prices and by creating greater economic incentives for the development and improvement for all competing providers.



Pursuant to T.C.A. § 65-5-112, as amended, Full Tilt Communications, LLC ("Full Tilt") submits this small and minority-owned telecommunications business participation plan (the "Plan") along with its Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide competing intrastate and local exchange services in Tennessee.

I. PURPOSE

Small Business. Small Business shall mean a business with annual gross receipts of less than four million dollars (\$4,000,000).

III. ADMINISTRATION

Full Tilt's Plan will be overseen and administered by the individual named below, hereinafter referred to as the Administrator, who will be responsible for carrying out and promoting Full Tilt's full efforts to provide equal opportunities for small and minority owned businesses. (6) Providing records and reports and cooperating in any authorized surveys as required by the Tennessee Regulatory Authority.

- Q. PLEASE STATE YOUR NAME, BUSINESS ADDRESS AND TELEPHONE NUMBER.
- A. My name is Greg Friedman. My business address is 242 Rangeline Road, Longwood, FL 32750-4035. My business telephone number is (731) 300-6441.
- Q. WHAT IS YOUR POSITION WITH FULL TILT COMMUNICATIONS, LLC?
- A. I am the Chief Financial Officer of Full Tilt Communications, LLC ("Full Tilt").
- Q. ARE ALL STATEMENTS IN FULL TILT'S APPLICATION TRUE AND CORRECT TO THE BEST OF YOUR KNOWLEDGE, INFORMATION, AND BELIEF?

Yes.

Q. WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF YOUR TESTIMONY IN THIS PROCEEDING?

A. The purpose of my testimony is to describe the services that Full Tilt proposes to offer in Tennessee, and to review issues related to Full Tilt's request for a license to provide such services. My testimony specifically addresses Full Tilt's managerial, technical, and financial competence to provide telecommunications services for which authority is requested, and its compliance with the rules and policies of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA").

Q. WHAT AUTHORITY IS FULL TILT SEEKING FROM THE TRA?

A. Full Tilt seeks authority to offer basic local exchange service in all incumbent local exchange carriers' service territories throughout the state of Tennessee.

O. IS FULL TILT LEGALLY AUTHORIZED TO DO BUSINESS IN TENNESSEE?

A. Yes. Full Tilt is a Delaware Limited Liability Company and has been authorized to do business in Tennessee. Full Tilt's Delaware Certificate of Formation is attached to its Application as Exhibit B and its authority to transact business in the State of Tennessee is attached to its Application as Exhibit C.

Q. PLEASE DESCRIBE YOUR BACKGROUND IN THE TELECOMMUNICATIONS INDUSTRY.

A. I have 17 years' experience in the telecommunications industry including finance, product management and telecommunications management. Further, the management team at Full Tilt has nearly 90 years of collective experience in the telecommunications industry as demonstrated in **Exhibit E** to Vero's Fiber's Application.

Q. PLEASE DESCRIBE FULL TILT AND THE TYPES OF SERVICES THAT IT WILL PROVIDE IN TENNESSEE.

A. Full Tilt is a is a Delaware limited liability company organized on August 15, 2019, with its headquarters in Longwood, FL. Full Tilt seeks authority to enter the Tennessee market as a provider of limited facilities-based local exchange service, specifically by primarily providing essential broadband and video services to schools and libraries by connecting district locations with fiber optic cable that provides reliable, scaleable, and secure connectivity through the federal E-rate program, and to other persons and businesses in Tennessee. Full Tilt intends to deliver an aggregation of technologies utilizing fiber optic cable depending on the customer's location and needs.

Full Tilt intends to deliver an aggregation of technologies utilizing fiber optic cable depending on the customer's location and needs. Full Tilt will offer leasing of dedicated fiber optic strands to allow schools and libraries to create their own privately-operated fiber optic network. This type of dedicated, purpose-built dark fiber networks are physically separate from other customers and controlled by the end-user. Full Tilt will also provide private lit fiber network for schools and libraries wanting assistance with running their networks and associated equipment.

Full Tilt desires to provide broadband service using fiber optic cabling that is either leased from other providers, placed within existing rights-of-way and/or conduits that are leased from other providers, or constructed within existing rights-of-way or via pole attachment arrangements. Full Tilt may seek to deploy its own facilities in or on existing structures. It is Full Tilt's understanding that without a license, incumbent local exchange carriers have refused to allow entities to use their conduit or poles. It is therefore necessary for Full Tilt to have a license so that it may obtain interconnection agreements with the incumbent local exchange carriers, pole attachment agreements with local utility companies, and franchise agreements and permitting arrangements with local municipalities in Tennessee. If requested by a customer and if financial feasible, the Applicant will also offer TDM telephone service through a special contract with the customer.

Q. DOES FULL TILT HAVE ADEQUATE ACCESS TO THE CAPITAL NECESSARY TO PROVIDE SERVICE INTENNESSEE?

- A. Yes, Full Tilt possesses the financial qualifications required of applicants for licenses. Full Tilt, through its parent company Vero Fiber Networks LLC, has access to the financing necessary to fulfill any obligations it may undertake with respect to the operation and maintenance of the services specified in the Application. Confidential Exhibit F contains pro forma financials for Full Tilt's parent company which demonstrates that it has adequate capital available to provide the proposed service in Tennessee. Because Full Tilt and its parent are privately held companies and their financial statements are not public information, I am requesting confidential treatment of this exhibit.

- A. Full Tilt intends to offer services in the entire state of Tennessee.
- Q. PLEASE DESCRIBE THE PUBLIC INTEREST BENEFITS ASSOCIATED WITH FULL TILT'S PROPOSED OFFERING OF LOCAL SERVICES IN TENNESSEE.
- Granting this Application will promote the public interest by increasing competition A. in the provision of telecommunications and video services in Tennessee. By benefits Full Tilt will bring significant competition, enhancing telecommunications users within Tennessee by providing: (a) lower-priced and better-quality service; (b) innovative telecommunications services; (c) efficient use of existing communications resources; and (d) increased diversification and reliability in the supply of communications services. Full Tilt's proposed intrastate services are designed to meet the telecommunications needs of subscribers and permit customers to realize cost savings in communications services. Accordingly, Full Tilt anticipates that its proposed service will provide its customers with better quality services and will increase consumer choice through innovative, diversified, and reliable service and equipment offerings. Full Tilt will comply with all rules and orders of the Commission. Applicant will promptly provide any other information requested by the Commission.


