NOTICE OF HEARING
TO BE HELD ELECTRONICALLY VIA WEBEX

This matter is before the Hearing Officer on the *Application of Full Tilt Communications, LLC to Provide Competing Local Telecommunications Services* (“Application”) filed by Full Tilt Communications, LLC (“Full Tilt” or “Applicant”) on April 15, 2020. This matter has been scheduled for a Hearing on the merits before the Hearing Officer at **10:00 a.m. CDT on Thursday, May 28, 2020**. Due to the state of emergency declared by Governor Bill Lee relative to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (“COVID-19”) pandemic, the Hearing will be held electronically via WebEx.¹ The ongoing state of public health emergency, which has been extended through June 30, 2020 in the entirety of the state, places limitations on public gatherings and meetings in order to prevent the spread of COVID-19². In convening the hearing electronically, the Commission relies upon Executive Order No. 16, issued by Governor Bill Lee on March 20, 2020³, and extended until June 30, 2020 in Executive Order No. 34, and affirms that such is necessary to conduct the essential business of the agency and to protect the health, safety, and welfare of Tennesseans.

Any motion to continue or reschedule the date of this Hearing must be made in writing and filed with the Office of the Chairman of the Commission by **Friday, May 22, 2020**.
