Dear Mr. Lawless:

Pursuant to Authority Rule 1220-04-01-.08, MCI Communications Services, Inc. d/b/a Verizon Business Services ("MCICS, Inc.") respectfully notifies the Tennessee Public Service Commission ("Commission") of its anticipated name change to MCI Communications Services LLC as the result of its planned conversion from a corporation to a limited liability company.

MCICS, Inc. plans to complete the conversion and name change by June 30, 2020. As a result, we have not yet registered the new name with the Office of the Tennessee Secretary of State. MCICS, Inc., therefore, requests a waiver of the requirement that verification of the registration be provided with this notice. We expect to be able to file this verification no later than July 30, 2020.

MCICS, Inc. received an exemption on November 10, 2000 from the surety bond requirement pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. 65-4-125. Therefore, no name change is required on any surety bond.

Customers will be informed of the entity name change in bill messages beginning May 2020. The language provided in the bill messages is as follows:

TO OUR LONG DISTANCE CUSTOMERS

On or after June 30, 2020 the name of the company providing your long distance service is changing from MCI Communications Services, Inc. to MCI Communications Services LLC. There will be no impact to your service as a result of this name change.

A check in the amount of \$25.00 is enclosed for the filing fee.
