Thank you for letter dated June 5, 2020, concerning providing broadband service to Mr. Robertson's home in Mississippi. Your correspondence has been placed in Docket No. 20-00080.

In Tennessee, AT&T has elected market regulation pursuant to T.C.A. 65-5-109. Under market regulation, the Commission retains jurisdiction over AT&T under a limited set of circumstances set forth in T.C.A. 65-5-109(n). According to the June 5, 2020 letter, Mr. Robertson will be provided service at his home in Mississippi from a central office location in Mississippi. The E-911 address that will be provided to Mr. Robertson's home is assigned to Mt. Pleasant, TN. Based upon my reading of the June 5, 2020 letter, it does not appear that the relevant subject matter is included in the jurisdiction afforded by T.C.A. 65-5-109(n). As such, no approval of the request to provide service to Mr. Robertson as described in your June 5, 2020 letter is required.
