TENNESSEE-AMERICAN WATER COMPANY'S NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL

On or about November 16, 2020, Tennessee-American Water Company ("Tennessee-American," "TAWC" or the "Company") respectfully submitted its Petition in the above-captioned matter seeking approval from the Tennessee Public Utility Commission ("TPUC" or "Commission") of the establishment of a regulatory asset. For the reasons that follow, Tennessee-American submits this *Notice of Withdrawal*, hereby formally withdrawing the Petition without prejudice.

I. BACKGROUND

On November 16, 2020, Tennessee-American submitted its Petition in this matter, along with supporting documentation. The Commission granted the Consumer Advocate Unit in the Financial Division of the Office of the Attorney General's ("Consumer Advocate" or "CAU") petition to intervene on January 7, 2021.

Pursuant to the request of the Hearing Officer, on or about March 4, 2021, the parties submitted a *Joint Proposed Procedural Schedule* in this matter. On March 30, 2021, the Hearing Officer issued the *Order Establishing Procedural Schedule*. After the completion of the discovery phase, TAWC and the CAU submitted a Stipulation and Settlement Agreement on or about

July 28, 2021. The Commission considered the Stipulation and Settlement Agreement on

August 9. 2021, and declined to accept it. As the Company continues to review and analyze the

challenging circumstances associated with the COVID-19 pandemic, including Commission

Docket No. 20-00047, Tennessee-American has concluded that the most appropriate path at this

stage is to withdraw the Petition without prejudice.

II. **CONCLUSION**

For the foregoing reasons, Tennessee-American respectfully withdraws its Petition in this

matter without prejudice.
