**ORDER GRANTING TENNESSEE-AMERICAN’S MOTION AND ESTABLISHING
AMENDED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This matter is before the Hearing Officer of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“Commission” or “TPUC”) for consideration of *Tennessee-American Water Company’s Motion to Amend Procedural Schedule* (“*TAWC’s Motion*”) filed on May 18, 2021. *TAWC’s Motion* asks the Commission to amend the procedural schedule established in this docket on March 31, 2021 because Tennessee-American Water Company’s (“TAWC” or the “Company”) primary witness is no longer with the Company, and TAWC needs additional time to identify a substitute witness. TAWC seeks to change the date for the filing of its Rebuttal Testimony and to change the target hearing date to the Commission Conference in July. *TAWC’s Motion* states the Consumer Advocate Unit in the Financial Division of the Office of the Tennessee Attorney General (“Consumer Advocate”) does not oppose *TAWC’s Motion*. On May 11, 2021, TPUC Staff issued a Data Request and TAWC’s Response raised some new issues in the docket. Consequently, the Consumer Advocate requested an opportunity to file Supplemental Testimony. On May 28, 2021, the parties filed the *Parties’ Joint Proposed Amended Procedural Schedule* that, in addition to reflecting the hearing date change requested in *TAWC’s Motion*, also established dates for the Consumer Advocate to file Supplemental Testimony

and TAWC to file Rebuttal Testimony that would address both the Consumer Advocate's Direct and Supplemental Testimonies. The Hearing Officer finds *TAWC's Motion* is well taken and should be **GRANTED**. Based on *Parties' Joint Proposed Amended Procedural Schedule*, the Hearing Officer hereby establishes the Amended Procedural Schedule set forth in **Exhibit A** attached to this Order.
