**Docket No. 21-00029** – *Petition for Approval of the Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement between BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Tennessee and Advantage Cellular Systems, Inc.*

**Docket No. 21-00037** – *Petition for Approval of the Interconnection Agreement between Peoples Telephone Company and Bandwidth.com CLEC, LLC (The Petition request approval of the adoption of the Interconnection Agreement negotiated between Peoples Telephone Company and Onvoy, LLC pursuant to Sections 251 and 252 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 and approved October 16, 2020 in Docket No. 20-00115).*

Any objection must be filed noting the specific docket number in which the agreement or amendment is filed and stating the specific reason(s) for the objection. If an objection is filed within the ten-day period, the agreement or amendment will not be deemed approved and will be scheduled for consideration before the assigned panel of Commissioners at a subsequent Commission Conference. If no objection to the agreement or amendment is filed within the ten-day period, the Commission will issue a notice memorializing approval of the interconnection agreement or amendment.
